General Instructions for Applicants

Please read the instructions below carefully

All complete applications submitted will be reviewed by the Rouge Park Natural Heritage Committee, a group designated by the Rouge Park Alliance to evaluate, prioritize and recommend Rouge River habitat rehabilitation projects to the Rouge Park Alliance for approval and funding.

All applications consistent with the following guidelines shall be considered:

1. Use the application form provided on this webpage:
http://www.rougepark.com/unique/restoration/2011/RP_Heritage_Application_Form_11.doc You can choose "File" from the menu, then "Save As" to download the Word Document application to your computer, and fill it out at your convenience. Then send completed application by email to heritageprojects@rougepark.com by 4:30 pm, August 30, 2010. Maximum acceptable email file size is 3 Mb.
2. Applications must limit project location to the Rouge River Watershed or portions of the Petticoat Creek watershed within Rouge Park but priority will be given to restorations in Rouge Park areas south of Steeles Avenue and the Little Rouge Corridor.
3. Applications should be straight forward and concise to a maximum of 5 double side pages
4. Project location(s): include all of the following information – municipality, subwatershed, nearest community, nearest major intersection. Provide an aerial photo, with street names labeled, that clearly outlines the project boundaries. Proposals that do not include such a map will not be considered. (The website <http://maps.google.ca> creates free maps, choose the satellite format.)
5. The Natural Heritage Committee will review applications, identify information gaps and establish project priority. Be concise and provide a clear description of the benefits of your project, funding partners and cost estimates.
6. All applicants will be given the opportunity to address the committee during a 10 minute question and answer period on the morning of September 8, 2010 (tentative). Rouge Park will contact applicants shortly after the submission deadline to make arrangements for your attendance at the committee.
7. Successful candidates will be required to sign an agreement form confirming that the applicant will comply with the *Funding Policies* and *Reporting Requirements* and any restrictions and/or conditions required by the Rouge Park Alliance.
8. Landowners/land managers, including TRCA, municipalities, private landowners, etc. will be required to give permission in writing before any project activity begins, including surveys etc. required to develop proposals.
